Format: Foil will be fenced as 1 round of Pools + Direct Elimination. Epee & Sabre will either be fenced as a Pool Unique or as Pool + DE depending upon the numbers on the day.
Please note: depending on numbers, some age groups, boys and girls may be mixed.

Medals Will be awarded for 1st, 2nd & equal 3rd in each category.

The Challenge: There will be a trophy for the highest scoring school based on the following points system. Based on their final position each fencer will score for their school 1 point, increasing by 1 point for each successive position up from the bottom, with medal winners increasing their points by a multiplier of 1.1 for bronze, 1.2 for Silver and 1.5 for gold. Please note all fencers are welcome to compete but only Schools can accumulate challenge points.

Entry fee: £10.00 Foil, £15 Foil + another weapon. Cheques payable to: **Winterfold House School**

Closing date: Friday 8th May. Entries after this date will be at the organiser's discretion

Equipment: All equipment must meet BFA standards. Breeches must be worn for U14 events.
The competition will be fought all electric scoring.

Membership: You must be a member of **BFA** to fence in this competition. Bring your card.

The organisers and the school accept no responsibility for loss or damage to fencers or equipment. The organisers make every attempt to ensure that the event takes places in a safe and secure way.
